





I The 2020 BPS payment rates in England were announced by the RPA on the 3rd November, and are £233.22 for Non-SDA, £231.57 for SDA and £63.95 for SDA Moorland. For 2020 the FDM is no longer deducted. I The predicted 2020 Scottish rates are £217.73 for Region 1, £43.13 for Region 2 and £12.90 for Region 3. I The 2020 Welsh rates are predicted to be £87.39 plus £91.97 Redistributive payment on the first 54 ha. I Northern Ireland have an expected average value of £203.26 subject to historical variation. I The minimum claim size is five hectares for England and Wales and three hectares for Scotland and Northern Ireland.
